Focus: *horizontal reflection & networking*
Composition: *heterogeneous - various disciplines, organisations, functions*
Objective: *interdisciplinary exchange, cross-networking, personal classification*

Travel diary

Serves as a *structuring reflection aid*
Combines content from working groups with personal impressions
Reinforces the individual learning curve and collective intelligence
